Out-of-court settlement goes to Make-A-Wish

A SEC worker was recently awarded \$180,000 in an out-of-court settlement as a result of a work related injury.

Voldik Jackiw, a 44-year-old Newborough boilermaker employed at the SEC's Morwell briquette plant, has since died, leaving his estate to the Make-A-Wish Foundation which grants the wishes of terminally ill children.

of-court settlement was made by solicitors acting for WorkCover and defendant, the SEC.

The settlement of \$180,000 was made on 24 March and Mr Jackiw died on 30 March. Mr Flanagan said that in Mr Jackiw's will he bequeathed his estate to the foundation.
