## **Man burned** by hot tar sues police

A MAN who claims he was handcuffed and pinned to a bitumen footpath hot enough to cook bacon and eggs is suing police for damages.

Omar Taha, 25, has filed a suit in the County Court seeking damages over his arrest in February 2000, on a day when the temperature reached 34.7C.

In his statement of claim, Mr Taha says he was arrested in the back yard of a Carlton house, handcuffed and then forcibly made to lie down on bitumen footpath the outside the house.

Mr Taha, of Brunswick, who was dressed in shorts and a T-shirt, claims the two arresting police offi-cers forced him to remain on the footpath while he complained that he could not breathe and he was in severe pain and was suffering burns.

Mr Taha alleges that it was not reasonably neces-

burns to his legs, arms and chest and now has residual scarring, anxiety and depression.

Mr Taha's solicitor Lee Flanagan, of law firm Arnold, Thomas & Becker, said his client would be seeking damages for pain and suffering, medical bills and for exemplary and aggravated damages.

The statement of claim lists as defendants the State of Victoria and the two arresting officers, one of whom is believed to be living in England.
